Tenured Professor at the Lisbon School of Law

Teaches Maritime Law, Commercial Law, Corporate Law and the Law of Obligations to the Bachelor Course. Lecturer of Aviation Law and Transport Law in the master's programme.

Hugo was the Scientific Advisor at the Bissau School of Law (2019-2022), where he coordinated several legislative reforms (namely, the Civil Code, the Civil Procedure Code and the judiciary legal framework) in cooperation with the UNDP and the Ministry of Justice and Human Rights.

Arbitrator at CREL – Centro de Resolução Extrajudicial de Litígios (Luanda, Angola).

With 20 years of practice, Hugo combines his practical knowledge in various fields (he was a lawyer in M&A, commercial contracts and project finance, as well as case handler at the Portuguese Competition Authority (financial sector), Legal Manager of the largest Portuguese property manager and Senior Legal Counsel of a tier 1 credit institution in Portugal) with sound legal knowledge, duly documented in several published works in the fields of Civil Law, Aviation Law, Maritime Law, Commercial and Corporate Law.

Frequent advisor in cross-border operations (namely in Angola) and in several high profile judicial and arbitration proceedings (Portugal, Angola and Guinea-Bissau).

Among his publications, the textbook on Aviation Law *Direito aéreo*, 2nd ed., AAFDL, 2024 (823 pages) and its Brazilian version *Uma introdução ao Direito Aéreo*, D'Plácido, 2024 (338 pages) are a reference for lusophone countries. His master's dissertation on pledge (*Do penhor*, Almedina, 2010, 380 pages) and his doctoral dissertation on *datio in solutum* (*Dação em pagamento*, Almedina, 2017, 998 pages) are often quoted by the Portuguese higher courts.
